Based on the OurSchool Survey results, our goal will be to maintain our goal to decrease the percentage of students who feel moderate to severe anxiety by 5%. It is noted that 32% of our students have expressed feelings of anxiety compared to the Canadian norm of 26%

Action	s / Initiatives to Maintain or Let Go
1 -	The Community Officer will be present at the school one day per week for community outreach and to provide support for students and continue to give presentations on <i>Sexto</i> . (Maintain)
2 -	Continuation on the workshop My Independance Matters to Me (Workshops on Prevention) by Maison Jean Lapointe will be presented to select groups from secondary 1-5 this year. (Maintain)
3 -	Additional supervision through the hiring of additional student supervisors for lunch, before and after school. (Maintain)
4 -	Additional individual support through the hiring of an additional special education technician. (Maintain)
5-	Homeroom groups for all levels which will create a sense of belonging and as well as an advocate for all students. (Modify)
6 -	Additional individual support through mentoring for students as needed. (Maintain)

7 - Collaboration with a Spiritual animator working from the school. (Maintain)
8 - Continuation of school wide activities to further develop sense of belonging and school spirit within the school. (Maintain)
9 - Collaboration with 4Korners for additional student support in school (Maintain)

Actions / Initiatives to Develop
