Dear Parents, Guardians and Students,

As this surreal school year ends would like to share some final information with everyone.

Last day of Classes

The last day of classes is June 23rd. Teachers will continue to communicate with the students about the plans for the individual classes.

End of Year collection

We are finalizing arrangements for the collection/return of Chromebooks, textbooks, sports Jerseys, class novels and library books as of June 25, 2020.

June 25th Sec 1, between 8am and 1pm

June 26th Sec 2, between 8am and 1pm

June 29th 3, between 8am and 1pm

June 30th Sec 4-5 and WOTP, between 8am and 1pm

We have arranged for a specific day for each grade level with consideration for families with more than one child at LTM. Bags with labels will be provided for you to deposit the chromebooks, which will then be sealed. You will be getting the sealed chromebook bag back in September. You must include the charger. Since we cannot verify the chromebook at pick up, please let us know if there is any problems with it.

All books (textbooks/novels/library) should somehow be identified with your child's name to avoid any mix up. Perhaps a Ziploc type bag with the student's name on it would ensure we check off the right student.

The same goes for sports jerseys; you must indicate the student's name on the outside of the bag.

Our staff will be there to help you however in order to make this process as quick and efficient as possible please make sure you follow these recommendations. If you are not able to come to LTM on your assigned day, please let us know.

Evaluations

Following the Ministry's directives, the following will be applied for the term 3 and final summary reporting of marks:

- A student's academic trajectory will not be negatively deviated as a result of the interruptions of educational services since March 13th.
- If a student was passing in terms 1 and 2, they will receive a final passing result.
- If a student was failing in terms 1 and 2, he or she may obtain a final passing grade IF they have demonstrated appropriate levels of competency.

➤ **Secondary 1-3 Levels:**

- Term 1 and 2 will be equally weighted. The results have not changed.
- The term 3 will indicate a P (pass), a NP (no pass), or a NE (not evaluated). Not evaluated will be used when there was not enough evidence of learning.
- The term 3 will be based on evaluations made between end of term 2 and March 13th PLUS pertinent observations on any work submitted after March 13th.

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- The final mark will indicate a P (pass) or a (NP).
- The final mark result will be based on the results for based on term 1 and 2 PLUS Evaluations between end of term 2 and March 13 PLUS pertinent observations on any work submitted after March 13th.
- There will not be a final mark in percentage form, nor a group average.

➤ Secondary 4-5 Levels:

- In term 3, there will not be a finally summary mark in a percentage, nor will there be a group average.
- The term 3 will indicate a P (pass) a NP (no pass) or a NE (not evaluated). Not evaluated will be used when there was not enough evidence of learning.
- The final mark will be in a percentage mark based on term 1 and 2 PLUS Evaluations between end of term 2 and March 13 PLUS pertinent observations on any work submitted after March 13th.
- The final mark will be weighted Term 1 40% and Term 2 60%, with possible adjustments in the final summary to reflect the ability of the student.
- The MEES will transform all results for the Secondary 4 and 5 transcripts to Reussite (REU for 60%-100% finals results) or Non Reussite (NRE for 0-50% final results)
